Blessings often seem to come from out of no where. For a teenager fending largely for himself and a well-to-do family in Memphis, Tenn., this seemed to be the case. You could almost say they were blindsided by the blessings that brought them together and by those they continue to receive as a result of their love for and commitment to each other.

But according to Leigh Anne, "He had a much greater impact on our lives than we did on his."

Tuohy will share her personal observations, from seeing Michael Oher for the first time to how the experience changed her as a person and the Tuohys as a family. Her message encourages people to recognize the full potential of individuals in their own communities and to find value in those who society has deemed valueless.

Almost two years after *The Blind Side* became a box office hit, Tuohy continues to make a difference.

In July 2010, Tuohy and her husband released the New York Times bestseller, *In a Heartbeat: Sharing the Power of Cheerful Giving*, and established their charity, Making it Happen.

# Lakeview Breaks Ground for Children's Building

A groundbreaking ceremony on Dec. 7, launched a \$6 million construction project that will result in a more therapeutic environment for children receiving outpatient mental health services at Lakeview Center.

The project includes construction of a three-story, 48,600-square-foot building that will allow Lakeview to provide all of its outpatient children's services in a single location that is both more comfortable and more convenient for families.

"Many times having a child who is diagnosed with a behavioral health issue can be traumatizing to the family unit," said Edna Williams, director of Children's Behavioral Health Services at Lakeview. "It is extremely important that we provide our services in a facility where these families feel supported and welcomed. That starts at the front door."

Last year Lakeview Center provided outpatient services for nearly 5,000 children. Located at the corner of Lakeview Avenue and "H" Street, the building is expected to be completed as early as winter 2011.

- An initiative with BHC, Cox and the Pensacola Breast Cancer Association yielded more than \$25,000 to support indigent mammograms.
