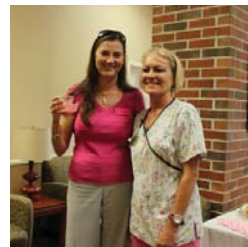

Time is running out to take advantage of a law that permits tax-free distributions to a charity from an individual retirement account (IRA) of up to \$100,000 per taxpayer, per taxable year. The law allows individuals to make these charitable transfers only in 2011.
